Following consultation on “Improving Visibility of Generation Investment” the Electricity Authority issued Transpower with a Clause 2.16 Notice. This requires Transpower to collect information on generation, energy storage and load developments proposing to connect to the grid, and to share this information monthly with the Electricity Authority.

When a new user is set up by the Transpower administrator they will receive an emailed link to the portal where they can set a new password. Two factor authentication is required to access the portal.

Once logged in a list of projects with basic details is displayed. This will be blank for new organisations who have not previously submitted development data.

If you have previously supplied Transpower with data, you will see your project information displayed. Your company’s project information is only visible to Transpower and users from your company.

Once created, a project or stage cannot be deleted. Instead set the project/stage status to cancelled for any projects you are no longer progressing.

Guidance for each data field is available by selecting the  icon next to the field

Some fields have pick lists to choose from using the  function

Some fields have data validation. An error message will display for invalid data with guidance on the validation rules.

After editing select save or cancel at the bottom of the page.
